SUMMARY:

On 05/13/13 Red Bluff Officers were dispatched to conduct a welfare check on Mary Carmelo after family members became concerned with her lack of contact. Officers found her Washington Street residence vacant, and her vehicles missing. Officers discovered Carmelo's wallet and phone inside her residence. The last known contact with family members was on 04/30/13.

Circumstances around Carmelo's disappearance are suspicious. One of Carmelo's vehicles was soon located abandoned in a nearby neighborhood. Carmelo's second vehicle was later recovered abandoned in Redding, CA.

The Tehama County Secret Witness is seeking the public's assistance and is offering a reward of up to \$3,500 (\$2,000 Greenville Rancheria; \$1,500 Secret Witness) for information leading to the discovery of Carmelo's whereabouts.
