SUMMARY OF INCIDENT: On February 7 2017 at 859 PM deputies responded to the area between Liberal Ave and South Ave Corning for a report of a white male dressed in white pants with no shirt trying to flag down vehicles and jumping into traffic on North Bound Interstate 5. When deputies arrived in the area TCSO dispatch received a 911 call from inside the Olive Pit warehouse located on Chase Ave. The unidentified male called 911 and stated, 6 to 8 people were chasing him and trying to kill him and he was in a pickle factory.

Deputies arrived on scene to find Clifford Ray Loffler dressed in white long john bottoms and 1 sock attempting to close a vehicle roll up door in the warehouse. Deputies observed several windows were broken and several olive gift baskets were placed on a cart and wheeled outside the warehouse. Deputies observed several jars of olives had been thrown and smashed outside the warehouse. Several olive jars were shattered within the warehouse as well. Deputies arrested Mr. Loffler on the above listed charges. Initial total damages and loss is estimated to be approximately \$3000.
