**Incident summary:**

On 02/25/17 at approx. 3:21 am Tehama County Deputies responded to the report of a trespass at an empty apartment complex located Sacramento Rd. in the Richfield area of Corning. Upon arrival Michael Rogers was contacted on the property in possession suspected stolen items. Mr. Rogers was found to have an outstanding warrant for his arrest out of Glenn County and was arrested and booked into the Tehama County Jail.

A more in depth investigation into the property Mr. Roger's had in his possession led to the discovery of items were stolen from a nearby residence and had not yet been discovered as stolen by the owners. The property recovered included a Kubota brand utility vehicle and chain saw that was identified by the owner who observed the vehicle at the apartment complex.

During the course of the investigation Jon Lareau's involvement in the theft surfaced and led to his arrest. Mr. Roger's part in the theft was expounded through evidentiary leads left at the crime scene that also linked Mr. Lareau to the theft.
