SUMMARY OF INCIDENT: On March 17, 2017 at about 8:00pm the Tehama County Sheriff's Office served a Search Warrant on Newville Road in Orland. Earlier that day, the TCSO had received information that numerous stolen vehicles and items were located at a residence on Newville Road. A flyover by CHP aircraft confirmed the presence of several vehicles matching the description of recent stolen vehicles.

Contact was made at the residence and it was secured prior to the issuance of the Search Warrant. After the service of the Search Warrant several stolen motorcycles, cars and pickups were located and recovered. The California Highway Patrol assisted in the identification and recovery of the vehicles. Numerous items were located laying about the property that had recently been reported as stolen from both Tehama County and Glenn County jurisdictions. Victims of the thefts were contacted throughout the night to respond to the location and retrieve some of the stolen items.

Michael Anthony Rogers was identified as a suspect in numerous burglaries to businesses, vehicles, and residences in the area. It is believed that he is living at the address on Newville Road and was in possession of a huge stockpile of stolen items. Some of the items believed to be stolen and recovered include; Chain saws, tree climbing equipment, laptops, various lawn care tools, hand tools, and a folding ladder.
