GENERAL LOCATION: Homeless encampment North of Antelope Blvd, in the slough area near the Sacramento River, Red Bluff (Also, known as Spider Island)

SUMMARY OF INCIDENT: On April 2, 2017 at 10:41 am Deputies responded to the Sand Slough area also known as Spider Island after a citizen was contacted and asked to call authorities due to a male that had been stabbed at that location.

A male was located deceased. Detectives responded to the area and during their investigation JESSE JACOBO was identified as the suspect in this case.

During the interview of JESSE JACOBO, he explained during a discussion JESSE JACOBO began arguing with the victim claiming the victim stole property belonging to JESSE JACOBO. As the argument escalated, JESSE JACOBO stabbed the victim.

JESSE JACOBO was arrested without incident and is being held in the Tehama County Jail.

Upon completion of Harvey McGlothin's autopsy the cause of death was determined to be multiple stab wounds.

Prior to this press release, Harvey McGlothin's next of kin was notified of this incident.
