**On April 28<sup>th</sup>, 2017 at about 09:15 AM deputies were contacted about college age adults camping in a remote, unimproved camp site in the State Wildlife Refuge, on the Highway 32 side of Tehama County. The reporting party described the campers as having left large volumes of litter, trespassing into posted closed areas of the Refuge and cutting down a number of trees in the area.**
