SUMMARY OF INCIDENT:

On Sunday Aug. 7, 2017 at about 1:12 AM, a Tehama County Sheriff's deputy was on routine patrol of the Flores Ave area of Tehama County. The deputy conducted a traffic enforcement stop on a Blue 1994 Buick for faulty lighting equipment. During the traffic stop the deputy learned that the passenger, Mr. Froman had a felony warrant for his arrest, out of Tehama County. Mr. Froman was placed under arrest for the warrant. During a search incident to the arrest deputies located several knives including a switch blade style knife on Mr. Froman's person.

Deputies had Mr. Conner step out of the vehicle and during searched of his person deputies located drug paraphernalia. During a search of the vehicle deputies located a loaded firearm under the front passenger seat where Mr. Froman was seated. The Colt Defender .45 Cal 1911 pistol was found to be reported stolen to the Red Bluff Police Department on July 19, 2017.

Both Mr. Froman and Mr. Conner were transported to the Tehama County Jail where they were booked on the charges listed above.
