SUMMARY OF INCIDENT:

On Sunday Nov. 19, 2017 at about 6:09 PM, Tehama County Sheriff's Deputies were dispatched to an assault with a deadly weapon at the Manton Trailer Park 31300 Manton Rd, Manton CA. Deputies contacted Mr. Goss who had a large laceration on his head. Mr. Goss told deputies that he had been struck in the head with a bottle by Mr. Maurer.

Mr. Whitlock reported to deputies that he had responded from his residence when he heard about the assault on Mr. Goss. Mr. Whitlock stated that he observed Mr. Maurer attempting to drive away from the scene and attempted to stop him by pursuing on Manton Rd and Wilson Rd. Mr. Whitlock stated that during the pursuit Mr. Maurer rammed the back of his pick-up with his vehicle. Mr. Whitlock stated that when Mr. Maurer again attempted to drive away he struck the passenger side of Mr. Whitlock's vehicle causing Mr. Whitlock's vehicle to spin out. Mr. Whitlock declined medical attention but complained of pain in his back from the accident.

Mr. Maurer contacted TCSO and stated he wished to speak to a deputy. Deputies responded and contacted Mr. Maurer in his vehicle. Mr. Maurer's story did not match the evidence and witness statements. Mr. Maurer was arrested and booked onto the Tehama County Jail.
