**1** Replace an old toilet with a WaterSense® labeled toilet and **save up to 4,000 gallons - that's \$100 a year**

**8** Upgrade to a WaterSense® labeled smart irrigation timer and **save up to 8,800 gallons**

**9** Convert to a drip system for more precise watering and **save up to 2,700 gallons - that's 65 loads of laundry**

**10** Use mulch to hold water and **reduce evaporation**
