SUMMARY OF INCIDENT:

On Monday Nov. 20, 2017 at about 12:12 AM, Tehama County Sheriff's Deputies were dispatched to an assault with a deadly weapon at 60 Byron, Red Bluff. It was reported that Mr. Kaufman was threatening Mr. Cary with a knife. When deputies arrived Mr. Kaufman had fled the scene in a White Ford Explorer. Mr. Cary had a Non-Life threatening laceration to abdomen from Mr. Kaufman stabbing him with a knife.

Deputies and Red Bluff Police Officers located the vehicle and conducted a traffic enforcement stop on the vehicle. Mr. Kaufman was located in the vehicle and arrested. Mr. Kaufmann was booked onto the Tehama County Jail.
