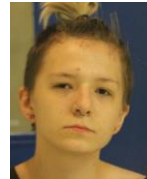

SUMMARY OF INCIDENT: Tehama County Deputies and Corning Police Officers responded to an alarm call at the Woodson Bridge Market located the intersection of South Ave. and Illinois Ave. in the Corning area. The business has been a target as of late to a team of burglars that have hit the market two other times within a weeks' time.

When authorities arrived on scene they discovered the front window to the market was smashed leaving a hole to the interior. Upon searching the property 3 suspects were located hiding behind the store in possession of bags of loot from the store. The loots consisted of items from the store e.g. cigarettes, pocket knives, beverages etc.

The listed persons were arrested for their involvement in the burglary and vandalism and are being investigated for the two other burglaries to the same business in the span of three days time.
