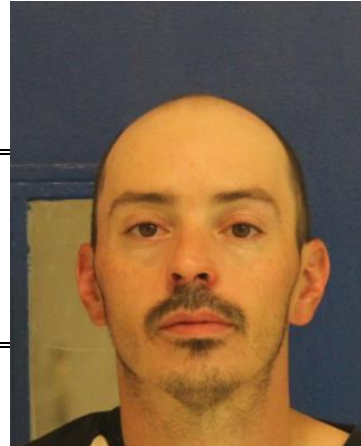

On 09/25/2018 at about 1807 hours, Tehama County Sheriff's Deputies responded to an address on McCoy Rd in Red Bluff for a report of a Burglary in progress. Upon arrival deputies contacted Rick Arrowsmith who reported that he had located a white truck parked in front of a residence that was owned by his son who he identified as Wesley Arrowsmith. Rick Arrowsmith was aware that the truck did not belong at the residence and he approached the residence to investigate who was at the residence.

Rick Arrowsmith located a male subject at the residence who he later identified through photos as Raymond McManus removing items. Rick Arrowsmith attempted to stop Mr. McManus from leaving the residence until law enforcement arrived and Mr. McManus fled the scene in his vehicle almost hitting Ricy Arrowsmith as he sped away from the residence striking a gate on the property.

Responding Deputies and officers from the California Highway Patrol searched the area and were unable to locate Mr. McManus's vehicle.

On 09/26/2018 at about 0217 hours a Tehama County Sheriff's deputy located Mr. McManus's vehicle and attempted to conduct a traffic stop. Mr. McManus fled from the deputy and a pursuit ensued westbound on Hwy 36W until the vehicle became disabled and Mr. McManus fled on foot. The vehicle Mr. McManus was driving was determined to have been reported stolen on 09/24/2018 during a burglary that was being investigated by the Tehama County Sheriff's Office.

On 09/26/2018 at about 0839 hours Wesley Arrowsmith contacted the Tehama County Sheriff's Office and reported that he had located Mr. McManus in a rural area off of Hwy 36W. Mr. Arrowsmith, who is a valid concealed weapon permit holder with the Tehama County Sheriff's Office held Mr. McManus at gunpoint until deputies arrived and placed Mr. McManus under arrest for the above charges.

This investigation is ongoing .
