SUMMARY OF INCIDENT:

On October 2, 2018 at about 12:52 AM a Tehama County Sheriff's Deputy observed a white Mitsubishi traveling at a high rate of speed southbound on Interstate 5 near North Main St. weaving in and out of other traffic. The Deputy attempted to catch up to the vehicle, but lost sight of the vehicle near Adobe Rd.

While checking the area the Deputy again observed the vehicle this time as it was exiting the Interstate at Antelope Blvd. The Deputy followed the vehicle as it ran through two red lights, and turned onto Gilmore Rd from Antelope Blvd. A traffic stop was initiated on Mina Ave.

During a search of the vehicle a loaded short barreled shotgun was found in the rear of the vehicle inside Mr. Hackett's backpack. A warrant check also revealed the passenger, Mr. Kubiak, had one felony and one misdemeanor warrant.

Both subjects were arrested and taken to the Tehama County Jail for booking. Additional drug charges will be requested for prosecution against both arrestees.
