T.I.D.E PRESS RELEASE

On 03/25/2019 at approximately 0219 hours Tehama County Sheriff's Deputies responded to the 14000 block of Warren Ave., Red Bluff to reports of gunshots. When Deputies arrived, they found lights on inside of the residence, and heard what they described as a man yelling inside the residence. Deputies announced their presence at which point a man (later identified as Johnny DAVIS) exited the residence and entered his vehicle. DAVIS exited the vehicle and was not complying with Deputies commands. After a brief standoff Deputies were able to detain DAVIS without incident.

Due to the report of gunshots and hearing a male yelling inside the residence, a protective sweep of the interior of the residence was conducted to ensure there were no injured people. No one else was found in the residence. During the protective sweep evidence of drug sales and illegal firearm activity were seen in plain view.

DAVIS was intoxicated to the point where he was unable to care for himself and was taken into custody for public intoxication.

Agents from the Tehama Interagency Drug Enforcement (TIDE) Task Force were called to assist. A search warrant was obtained for the residence and the residence was searched. Agents located a large amount of suspected Anabolic Steroids with a suspected value of about \$75,000, evidence of steroid sales, 2 firearms, expended shell casings, 3 high capacity magazines, and evidence of recklessly discharging a firearm inside the residence.

Additional charges were filed on DAVIS for possession of steroids with the intent to sell/distribute, possession of high capacity magazines, and reckless discharge of a firearm.
