On 04/08/2019 at about 1613 hours, Tehama County Sheriff's Deputies responded to a report that a subject had fired 7-8 shots from a black and red Harley Davidson motorcycle in the area of Valley Vista Drive.

The motorcycle was seen at the Econolodge in Corning shortly thereafter. Deputies located the motorcycle in the area of Highway 99W near Olivewood Drive and attempted to conduct a traffic stop. The motorcycle failed to stop and deputies and officers from the Corning Police Department initiated a pursuit which lasted several minutes in the Corning area.

During the pursuit the motorcycle reached speeds in excess of 100 MPH and the driver discarded a firearm in the area of Olivewood Dr.

The motorcycle came to a stop at a residence on Flournoy Ave and the driver, Mr. Humphrey was taken into custody.

A sheriff's K-9 was used to locate the firearm on Olivewood Drive, which the suspect had discarded there.

The initial reporting parties identified Mr. Humphrey as the person who had shot at them several times while he rode his motorcycle on Valley Vista Dr. The victim was not struck by any of the rounds fired by Mr. Humphrey and there were no injuries sustained as a result of this incident.

Humphreys was booked into the Tehama County Jail for the above listed charges.
