On 05/01/2019 at about 1102 hours the Tehama County Sheriff's Office received a report from the Oakland Air Traffic Control that a Cessna aircraft had suffered total engine failure in the area of Hwy 36E in Mineral area of Tehama County.

Emergency personnel including Cal Fire, Tehama County Sheriff's Office and Cal Trans responded to the area to locate the aircraft.

Upon arrival emergency personnel located the aircraft with obvious damage in a meadow near Hwy 36E and Hwy 172.

Emergency personnel also located the 3 occupants of the aircraft. 1 occupant was deceased at the scene and the remaining 2 occupants had serious injuries and were airlifted to area hospitals and their condition is not known at this time.

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) and the National Transportation Safety Board (NTSB) have been advised of the incident and will be conducting the investigation of this incident.

The Tehama County Sheriff's Office will be working closely with the FAA and NTSB to assist with their investigation as needed.

The names of all occupants are being withheld at this time pending notification of family members.
