On 09/20/2019 at about 2218 hours Tehama County Sheriff Deputies responded to a report of a disturbance at in the area of 229 San Mateo Ave in Gerber. Upon deputies arrival they contacted the alleged victims who reported being assaulted by 3 men with a baseball bat.

During the investigation deputies learned that Mathew Ebersole and Michael Kunick as well as a third unidentified male had caused a disturbance with the victims over a neighborhood dispute. It is reported that during the disturbance a baseball bat and a hammer were used to strike the victims in the head multiple times causing injuries.

Deputies located both Mr. Ebersole and Mr. Kunick on scene however a third suspect left the area prior to deputies arrival.

Both victims sustained injuries to their head as a result of the assault and were treated for their injuries.

Both Mr. Ebersole and Mr. Kunick were placed under arrest for the above listed charges and booked into the Tehama County Jail.

This investigation is ongoing and deputies are attempting to locate and identify the third suspect.
