PRESS INFORMATION

TYPE OF INCIDENT: Active Shooter Incident

On June 27, 2020 at about 3:32 pm, The Tehama County Sheriff's Office received multiple 911 telephone calls of an active shooter incident at the Walmart Distribution Center.

Deputies and local Law Enforcement officers from allied agencies began responding to the scene. Red Bluff Police Department was the first to arrive on scene at 3:36 pm, this solo officer engaged the suspect, later identified at **Louis Lane**. **Lane** engaged the Red Bluff PD Officer in an exchange of gunfire where numerous shots were exchanged. Moments later, a second Red Bluff PD Officer arrived on scene and engaged **Lane** who was still shooting at the first officer on scene.

At 3:38, **Lane** who had been shot by Red Bluff PD was neutralized. **Lane** was medically treated, taken to a local area hospital where he was pronounced deceased.

While **Lane** was being taken to a local area hospital, Tehama County Deputies along with the assistance of Red Bluff PD, CALFIRE, CHP (GROUND & AIR UNITS), Corning PD, Department of Fish & Wildlife and Tehama County Probation conducted a systematic search of the scene for additional victims of **Lane's** shooting or additional suspects of which none were found. Based on evidence at the scene, video surveillance and witness statements investigators determined **Lane** acted alone.

Upon further investigation it was later learned that **Lane** had been witnessed driving through and around the Walmart DC parking lot (4) times prior to crashing his vehicle into the lobby area of the building. Upon impact the vehicle caught on fire, as **Lane** exited the vehicle with a semi-automatic rifle and began shooting randomly into the building and through the parking lot area where he was engaged by Red Bluff PD. The fire was quickly suppressed.

During this incident, a total of (6) individuals were transported to local area hospitals with injuries ranging from minor to moderate. As TCSO Deputies arrived on scene, Martin Haro-Lozano was found injured. Due to the extent of his injuries, Deputies placed Mr. Haro-Lozano into their vehicle and transported him to the nearest hospital where he died from his injuries. This part of the investigation is in its preliminary stages and nothing further can be provided at this time. Mr. Haro-Lozano was an employee of Walmart when this incident occurred.

It was learned that **Lane** had worked at Red Bluff Area Walmart DC in February 2019 but had been released from employment due to failing to show for his shift. **It was determined that this incident is NOT related to the Homicide Investigation currently being investigated by the Shasta County Sheriff's Office in Shingletown.**

This investigation is still in its early stages and the TCSO is being assisted by several agencies. The Tehama County Sheriff's Office is investigating the criminal aspect of this case. The Tehama County District Attorney's Office Bureau of investigation is investigating the Officer involved shooting aspect of this case. The Department of Justice is on scene helping with the crime scene as well as CHP's M.A.I.T (Multidisciplinary Accident Investigation Team) who is assisting with the accident portion of this investigation. These agencies are expected to be working throughout the remainder of this evening and into tomorrow before the scene will be completely processed.

Autopsies will be conducted Monday, June 29, 2020, after which an updated press will be released.
