The Tehama Major Crimes Unit is investigating 2 shootings that occurred at the Homewood Mobile Home Park that occurred over the past week.

The first incident occurred on Saturday, January 23, 2021 at about 2330 hours. In this incident an adult male reported that he was parked in front of the Homewood Mobile Home Park when he was approached by an unknown male who was armed with a firearm. The victim reported that the unknown suspect fired multiple rounds at him with 1 round striking him in the left leg.

The victim drove himself to a local hospital where he was treated for a non-life threatening injury to his left leg and was later discharged.

The second incident occurred on Tuesday, January 26, 2021 at about 1930 hours. Tehama County Sheriff's Deputies responded to a report of a shooting at the Homewood Mobile Home Park. Upon deputies arrival they located a 38-year-old male victim who had suffered a gunshot wound to the head. The victim was transported to an area hospital and is currently listed in critical condition.

Investigators with the Tehama Major Crimes Unit responded to the scene and are actively investigating both incidents. At this time it is undetermined if these incidents are related.

Witnesses reported seeing a silver sedan leaving the area at a high rate of speed shortly after the shooting.

This investigation is ongoing and further information will be released as it becomes available.
