Charge: Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On 052921 at about 2310 hours, a drive by shooting occurred in the 1500 block of Johnson St., Red Bluff. A white sedan was identified as driving by a residence and firing numerous rounds from what was later determined to be a .22-caliber firearm. The unknown subjects fired at a residence which had several young adults outside on the front porch area. During the shooting, two people were struck by bullets. Several shell casings were recovered from the scene.

The Red Bluff Police Department is seeking the assistance from anyone who may have knowledge or information regarding the shooting. The Red Bluff Police Department has partnered with the Tehama County Secret Witness and is offering a \$1,000.00 reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person's responsible for the shooting.
