GENERAL LOCATION: Highway 36 east and area of Highway 32 to the Butte and Plumas County lines

DATE AND TIME: July 31st, 2021 8:00 AM

Change in status to the Fire Evacuation Warnings and Orders in Tehama County due to the Dixie Fire

On July 31st, 2021 the Tehama County Sheriff's Office, in cooperation with Cal Fire Incident Management Team 1, who is currently working on the Dixie Fire, has reduced the evacuation warnings and orders as listed below for residents in the eastern part of Tehama County.

Evacuation **ORDERS** have been <u>reduced</u> to Evacuation **WARNINGS** for the following areas: To include the area of Colby Creek, the warning will begin at the Butte and Tehama County line, west along the Tehama County Line to the intersection with SR32, north along the SR32 corridor to the intersection with SR36, from the intersection with SR32 and SR36, east along SR36 to the intersection with Plumas and Tehama County Line.

These zones are listed as D18, E17, E18 and E19 on the map available on the Sheriff's web site and on the Tehama County Transportation Commission web site.

Evacuation **WARNINGS** have been <u>lifted</u> for the following: communities south of the Mill Creek community, continuing south to the north side of the community of Campbellville and east to highway 32.

These zones are listed as C18, C19, D16, D17, D19 and E16 on the digital mapping system.

Please use caution in these areas as you return, there are still many firefighters and utilities personnel working in the area to make sure it remains safe for your return.
