Description



Performs advanced journey level work in the maintenance and repair of County buildings and grounds; performs limited janitorial duties

Examples of Duties

- Performs scheduled and emergency building, equipment maintenance, and repair work on County Buildings and grounds.
- Installs and repairs wiring, switches, light ballasts, and other electrical systems. May perform diagnostic testing in order to determine maintenance needs as necessary.
- Performs light carpentry in the maintenance of assigned buildings. Repairs furniture, builds shelving units and assists in minor remodeling of buildings.
- Performs basic periodic servicing of heating and/or cooling systems including making adjustments, oiling and lubricating, cleaning filters and tightening belts.
- Installs and repairs valves, faucets and pipes; clears clogged drains and performs other general plumbing and maintenance and installation work.
- Installs and repairs flooring and ceiling materials.

Knowledge of:

- Basic electrical, plumbing, HVAC, mechanics, welding, carpentry, masonry and painting methods and techniques.
- Operations, tools and terminology used in building and grounds maintenance.
- Methods used in the maintenance of tools, machinery and equipment.
