



Tehama County Deputy Sheriffs' Association Family Scholarship Application 2025

Each year, the Tehama County Deputy Sheriffs' Association (DSA) offers a scholarship of up to \$1,000. This opportunity is open to:

- Graduating high school seniors who are continuing their education,
- Current students enrolled in trade schools, and
- Current students attending a college or university.

Applicants must have an immediate family member* who is associated with the Tehama County Sheriff's Office. This includes any family member who works for or volunteers with the Sheriff's Office.

The scholarship selection process considers all aspects of the application, including academic performance, school activities, community involvement, and personal character. All submitted information will remain confidential and will only be used to assess eligibility for this scholarship. No single factor carries more weight than another. However, all required information must be provided.

**Immediate family members include children, siblings, nieces, nephews, and grandchildren.*

Please Note:

If there are multiple qualified candidates, the scholarship may be divided among the recipients. Scholarship checks will be sent directly to the recipients upon receipt of written proof of enrollment in their respective educational institutions.

Scholarship Award Details

- **Notification:** Scholarship recipients will be notified before graduation.
- **Selection Process:** The scholarship committee will review applications, screen candidates, and conduct interviews with the most qualified applicants.
- **Publicity:** Upon request, recipients must provide a photograph suitable for publicity purposes.

Application Procedure

To apply, please submit the following items:

1. **Cover Letter:** In 500 words or less please answer the following questions.
 - Tell us about yourself and your plans for college.
 - How has public safety positively impacted your life and community?
2. **Completed Application Form**
3. **Copy of Transcript(s)**
 - A certified transcript is not required.
